It has been developed by curriculum experts to convey important messages to this age group about the world of public transport. The resource:

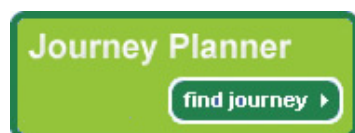
- is relevant (curriculum based) and easy to use.
