About Community Transport Calderdale

Community Transport Calderdale (CTC) is a local independent charity based at Luddendenfoot that operates three projects:

- 1. Community Car Services** - a group of volunteers drive their own cars to help people get to appointments, etc.
- 2. Minibus service** - a fleet of seven accessible minibuses take individuals or community groups on not for profit journeys
- 3. Community bus service** - operating public bus routes for communities that do not have existing bus routes.

The aim of CTC is to provide transport for those residents of Calderdale that cannot access existing forms of transport provision for reasons of ill health, disability, isolation, poverty or social exclusions.

CTC operates with employed and volunteer staff, all trained to industry standard qualifications.
