# The start of something new and exciting

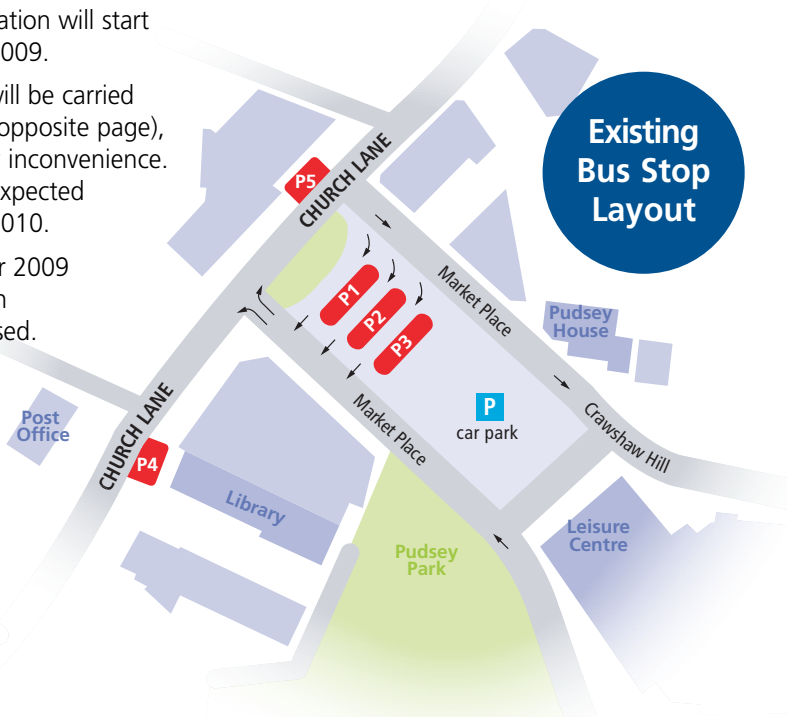
**Metro is redeveloping Pudsey Bus Station to provide new facilities, with higher levels of comfort, in line with other Metro bus stations across West Yorkshire.**

Work on the new bus station will start on Sunday 25 October 2009.

The construction work will be carried out in three stages (see opposite page), in order to minimise any inconvenience. The new bus station is expected to open by September 2010.

From Sunday 25 October 2009 the short stay car park in Market Place will be closed.

Temporary loading bays will be provided for deliveries and access to Crawshaw Hill and the Leisure Centre car park will be maintained at all times.



## The new Pudsey Bus Station will be fully accessible and will include:

- New passenger island with central enclosed waiting area
- New real-time electronic passenger information
- CCTV surveillance – monitored 24 hours a day
- New seating, lighting and flooring
- Improved accessibility
- Improved highways arrangements with new footpaths and crossing points

## Stage 1 From Sunday 25 October 2009

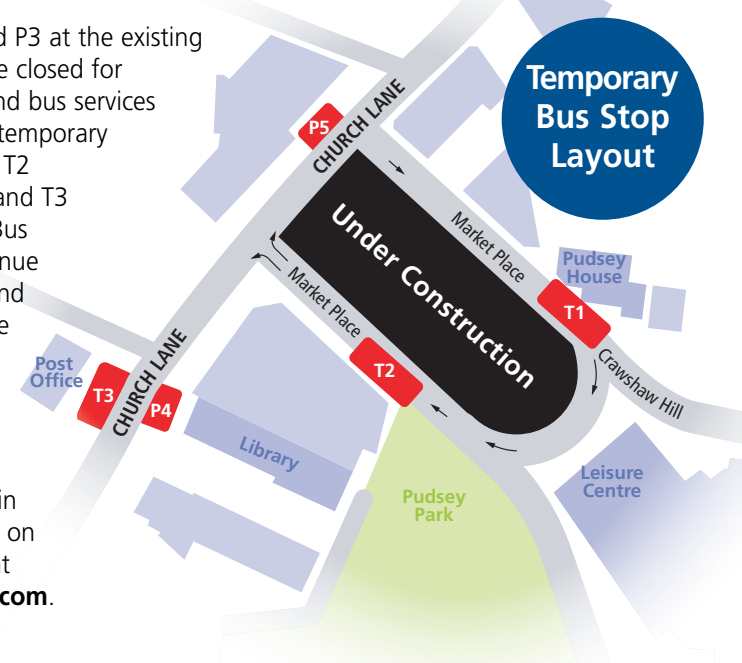
During stage 1 bus services will continue to depart from the existing bus station and from the existing stops in Church Lane.

From Sunday 25 October 2009 the existing short stay car park in Market Place will be closed and alternative parking will remain available behind the Leisure Centre. (Leeds City Council will provide additional information posters in the car park and further details can be obtained by contacting Leeds City Council on 0113 222 4407).

## Stage 2 Due to start in January 2010

Stands P1, P2 and P3 at the existing bus station will be closed for redevelopment and bus services will use the new temporary bus stops T1 and T2 in Market Place, and T3 in Church Lane. Bus services will continue to use stops P4 and P5 in Church Lane as normal.

## Stage 3 Due to start in Summer 2010

During stage 3, work will be carried out on the highway and footpaths in Market Place and Church Lane. This work will be carried out in phases in order to minimise disruption. When the new bus station is complete, temporary stops T1, T2 and T3 will be removed and the bus services using these stops will use the new bus station.
