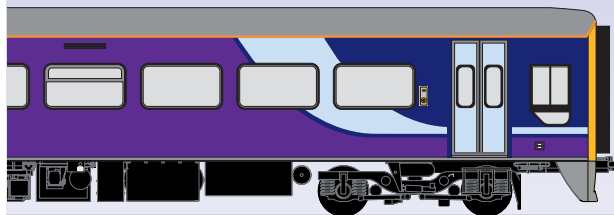

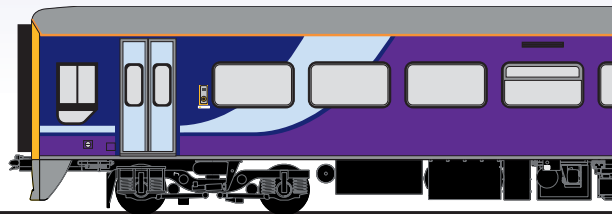

## Zone 6 and Zone 7 rail tickets

It is now even easier for regular train users to travel in and out of West Yorkshire from Harrogate and Skipton as Metro and Northern introduce the new Zone 6 and Zone 7 rail tickets.

The tickets are valid on all direct train services between Harrogate (not via York) or Skipton to West Yorkshire and include unlimited train travel within West Yorkshire. They are not valid on any special train services which operate such as charter services.

### Benefits of the new Zone 6 and Zone 7 tickets include:

- Unlimited travel on train services within the zones chosen.
- Weekly, monthly, quarterly and annual options.
- No price changes while the ticket is valid.
- No hunting for change to buy a ticket for each journey.
- Stress free travel with no traffic jams.

### Rail Zone 1 - 5 + 6

Unlimited train travel from Harrogate (rail zone 6) to and from West Yorkshire rail zones 1 to 5.

### Rail Zone 1 - 5 + 7

Unlimited train travel from Skipton (rail zone 7) to and from West Yorkshire rail zones 1 to 5

£39.60	£152.50	£457.50	£1,587.00

Both the Zone 6 and the Zone 7 RailCards require a PhotoCard. This can be either the National Rail PhotoCard or a Metro PhotoCard.

## Where can I buy a Zone 6 or Zone 7 ticket?

Zone 6 and 7 RailCards are only available from staffed rail stations in West Yorkshire, plus Harrogate and Skipton in North Yorkshire. They are not available on-train from the conductor, staffed bus stations, Post Offices, by post, on-line or through other third party issuing outlets.

Zone 6 and 7 RailCards are not available to purchase from Metro through the Corporate MetroCard scheme.



### Additional Information:

Unlike MetroCard, Zone 6 and Zone 7 tickets are not valid on any bus services in either North Yorkshire or West Yorkshire.

Zone 6 tickets cannot be used for travel in Zone 7 and vice versa.

Zone 6 and Zone 7 tickets are not an 'add on' ticket which can be purchased to use in conjunction with an existing MetroCard product.

Discounted rail travel for English National Concessionary Pass holders is not available in Zones 6 or 7.

Train times and a map of West Yorkshire's rail network with Zones 6 and 7 are included in the West Yorkshire Train Times booklet.
