Senior passes for bus and train travel

If you are aged 60 or over, the English National Concessionary Pass entitles you to free public transport.

Bus

The English National Concessionary Pass entitles anyone aged 60 or over to free, off-peak bus travel throughout England.

From 6 April 2010, the way in which English National Concessionary Passes are issued is changing.

Train

For West Yorkshire residents, your English National Concessionary Pass also entitles you to off-peak train travel within West Yorkshire for just 35p.

Note: From 23 May 2010 the cost of off-peak train travel will change to 50p.

Off-peak times

Off-peak is after 9.30am* Monday to Friday, and all day at weekends and bank holidays.

Bus pass exclusions

You cannot use the Pass on certain special bus services, excursions, tours, private hire vehicles, school and works contract services, and services for which you need to pre-book.

Train travel outside West Yorkshire

If part of your train journey includes points outside West Yorkshire, you must pay the additional fare before you travel. This will normally be the full adult fare for the non-West Yorkshire section of your journey.

If you do not pay for the non-West Yorkshire part of the journey before setting off, you may be charged the full adult fare for the entire journey. Fares may be combined only to and from a station at which your train makes a scheduled stop.
