Completed projects: Rail shelter replacement

New shelters for rail stations within West Yorkshire

3 July 2008

Following on from the success of the first two phases of the Metro-funded rail shelter replacement programme, Metro has recently completed the third and final phase at a cost of 629k.

The scheme has provided new passenger waiting shelters at the following stations:

- Berry Brow
- Crossgates
- Frizinghall
- Burley in Wharfedale
- Mirfield
- Mytholmroyd
- Shepley
- Walsden

A total of 14 shelters has been replaced. The works started in Spring 2006 and were completed in November 2006. The scheme was funded by Metro and delivered by Northern Rail.
